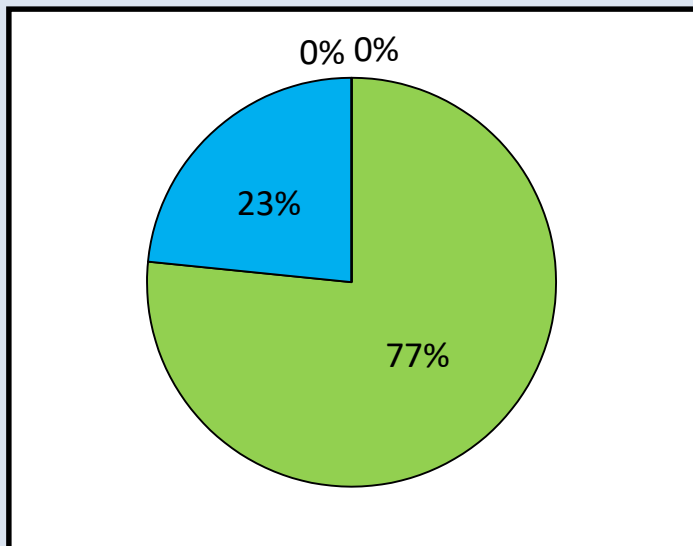

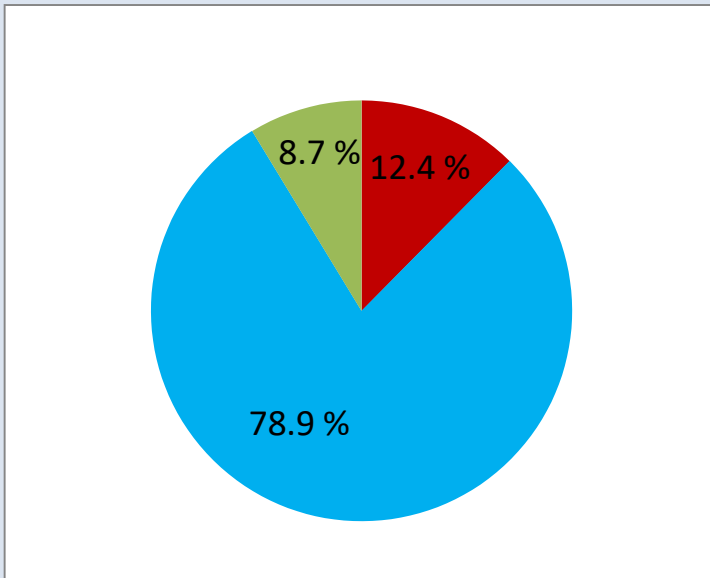
1. Do you think the curriculum workload is affordable by your ward

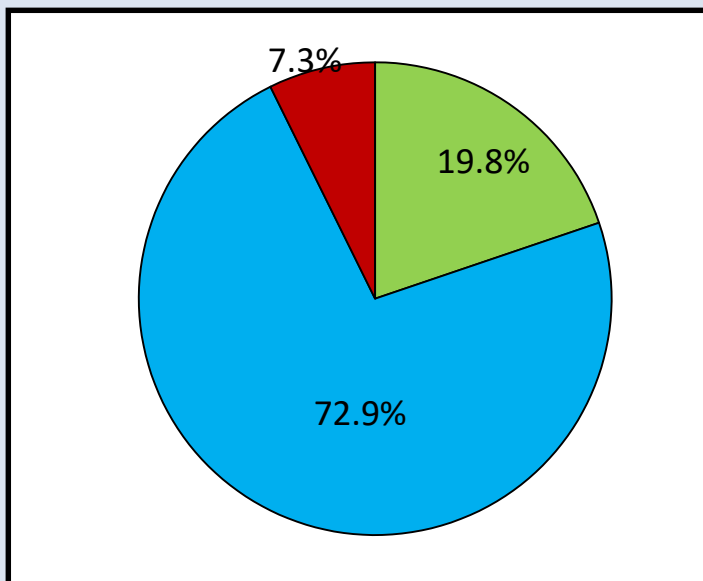
2. Rate accessibility of content/reference books

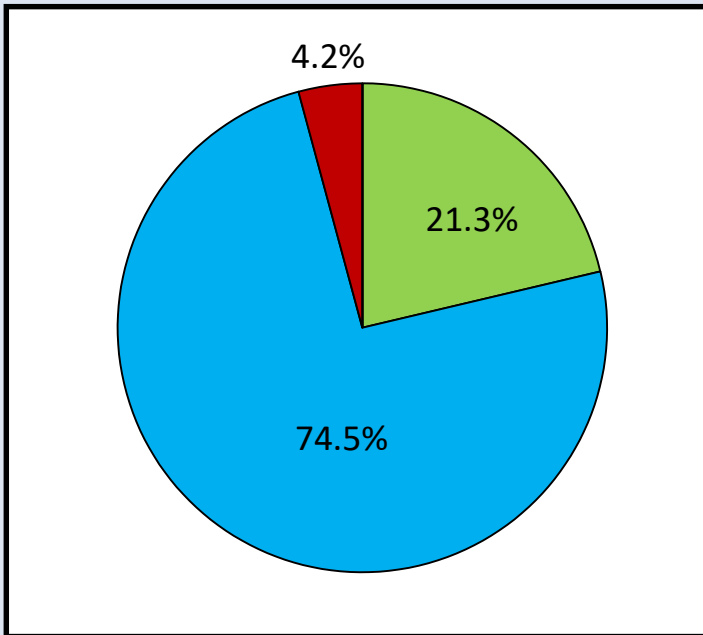
3. Rate the advantages your ward has got from the course

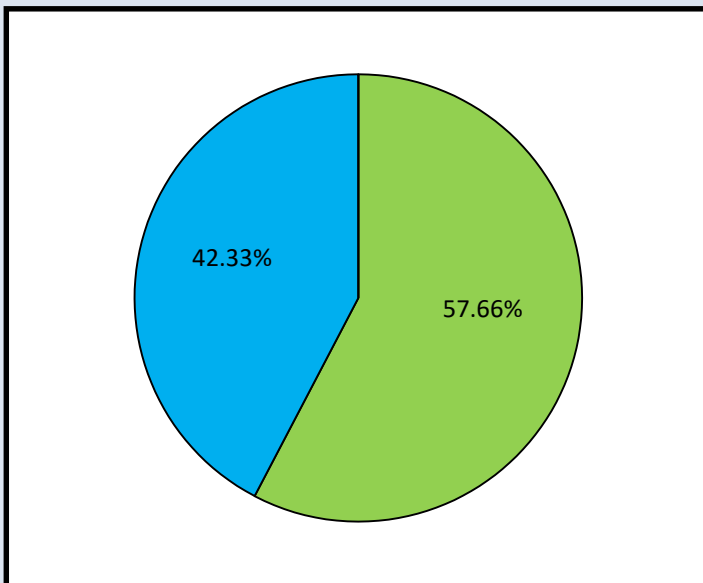
4. Rate the change of your ward after fulfilment of the course

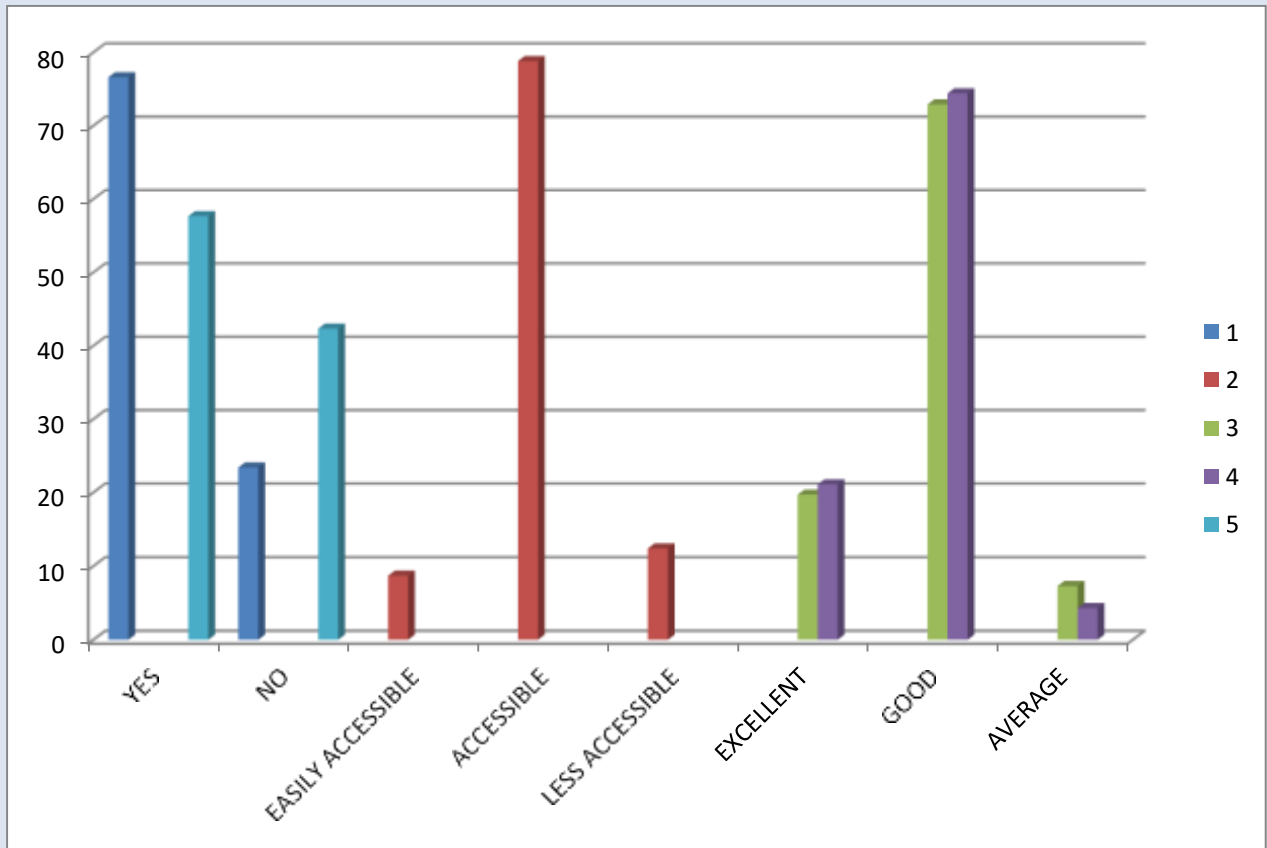


5. Does the courses in educational modules advance business entrepreneurs and students are stimulated to initiate startups:

FEEDBACK ON CURRICULUM BY PARENTS ANALYSIS REPORT

Al-Ameen College, Edathala is a post graduate college with 11 under graduate programs and 3 post graduate programs. The college is affiliated to Mahatma Gandhi University, Kottayam and all the programs are following the syllabus designed and approved by respective Board of Studies of Mahatma Gandhi University.

Feedback on curriculum was collected from students, teachers, parents as well as alumni. Almost 77% parents opinioned that curriculum workload is affordable by students. They also rated the accessibility of content. About 79% supported the accessibility through Moodle and INFLIBNET facilities provided by the college to access the syllabus, notes etc. Almost 73% parents remarked that the advantage of the course was good. They improved in their various personal skills such as communication skill. And also they received placements. Almost all the departments provide skill development training programme for students.

About 75% parents commented that the change of students after completing the course as good. They also received opportunity to attend certificate courses which enhances their qualities. Almost 58% parents say that the students were stimulated to initiate startups after completing their course.
