RUPEE DEPRECIATION RISKS AND CHALLENGES

Department of Economics organized UGC sponsored two day National Seminar on “Rupee Depreciation – Risk and Challenges” on 6th & 7th October 2015. Sri.Suhas.IAS,Sub, Sub Collector, Fort Kochi, inaugurated the seminar. He stressed on the importance of Rupee depreciation from the view point of common man. Rupee depreciation is simply the rise in the price level of commodities in the market. Prof. Rajan Varughese, former PVC MG University and HOD, Department of Economics, UC College. Aluva gave the Keynote address. He made a good reference to the initial history and period of changes in the international currency conversion. Adv. T.P.M. Ibrahim Khan,Chairman, Al-Ameen Educational Trust delivered the presidential address and discussed the impact of rupee depreciation on the Indian economy. Dr.M.I.Junaid Rahman,Manager,Al-Ameen College, Edathala offered his remarks on the topic and the academic relevance of the subject. Research papers were presented by scholars from various institutions. A total of 89 participants attended,which included faculty, research scholars and post graduate students. The presented papers were brought together in the form of Seminar Proceedings.



SCOPE AND CHALLENGES IN TRANSLATION WITH REFERENCE TO ENGLISH, HINDI, MALAYALAM AND ARABIC

The two day seminar, *Scope and Challenges in Translation with Reference to English, Hindi, Malayalam & Arabic* was conducted on 17th and 18th of February 2016 in an exemplary manner. Four well structured sessions were guided by people of eminence. Though there are machines to make translation easy it requires the unmitigated skill of the translator as there is increasing interdependence of various disciplines ranging from literature to medicine and mass communication. Keeping this in mind, the seminar discussed several thrust areas that are vital for contemporary translation works. The keynote address was by Prof. Devaki Antharjanam where the discussion was about how translation has been influencing a language in its evolution. A special reference to our mother tongue, Malayalam by spotting new styles and words in vogue was also a highlight of her talk. In addition, the talk by Dr. M. Sherief widened our perspectives on translation in Malayalam. New and less explored areas were revealed through the paper presented by Prof. C.S. Jayaram with regard to translation in culture, politics and film. In the next session, Dr. R.Sukumaran, delivered a special talk on the influence of translation on Hindi. Sujith Sudhakar from Keltron IMT addressed the gathering on scope and challenges in the area of medical transcription. The two day seminar was an enlightening one in this rather unexplored, yet important area in the overall fabric of the languages that were discussed.



International Ozone Alert Day

Ozone Alert Day 2015 was celebrated by the Department of Biotechnology with the support of Kerala State Council for Science, Technology and Environment on 23rd September 2015. Dr. Junaid Rahman, Manager, Al-Ameen College inaugurated the programme. The



inauguration was highlighted by the presentation of saplings to the participant colleges. The keynote speaker was Dr.Venu G.Nair, Assistant Professor, Dept of Atmospheric Science, CUSAT. He delivered a talk on “Ozone and its impact on living system”. An Intercollegiate quiz competition and painting competition were held. Sri C. R Neelakandan, the famous environmentalist handled the afternoon session on “Development policy based on ozone”. To commemorate this event Sri C.R Neelakandan planted a sapling of “Lakshmi Tharu” in our Herbal Garden.

WORKSHOP ON ENERGY EFFICIENT AND ECO FRIENDLY LED BULB ASSEMBLING

The Post Graduate Department of Physics organized "Workshop on Energy and Eco friendly LED Light Bulb Assembling" in connection with the National Science Day with the Sponsorship of Kerala State Council for Science, Technology and Environment and the support of Department of Science and Technology, Govt. of India on 20th February. Dr. Suresh Nair, Chief Technology Officer, Nest Group inaugurated the workshop and addressed the students. The talk was successful in elucidating the importance of this technological workshop and in inculcating an interest in new trends taking place in the energy efficient lighting systems.

Dr. S. Sankararaman, Associate Professor, Nirmala College, Muvattupuzha delivered a talk on the basics of LED. He presented an energy audit report to make the students aware of the need for replacement of the conventional lighting by eco friendly and energy efficient LED Bulb. The technical session started with the very basic technique of use of soldering iron, specification of various components used in the assembling etc. This session helped the students to understand the basic procedure of assembling components like capacitor and resistor for making various kinds of LED lights. Students were provided with a kit containing a soldering iron and 2 LED light bulbs of 7 Watts and 9 Watts. The bulbs provided were unassembled. Under the supervision of the Resource Person, the students assembled the bulbs.



COMBINED ANNUAL TRAINING CAMP OF NCC (CATC)

A ten day combined annual training camp for NCC cadets-boys and girls from various districts was conducted at Al-Ameen college, from 21st August to 30th August 2015. The Camp was organized by 22 K (Bn) NCC unit of Eloor. Five hundred and ninety eight cadets participated in the Camp. Thirty institutions from 22 K (Bn) NCC Unit and four Institutions from 1 Kerala Battalion of Cherthala & Alappuzha (Districts) took part in the Camp. The Commanding Officer Lieutenant Colonel Mario D Monty gave the presidential address and spoke about training discipline and motto of the camp. Training was imparted to the cadets on various subjects such as drill, weapon training, map reading, first aid, adventure, self defence, military history, physical fitness, field craft and battle craft.

RED ENERGY 2015-16

Exhibition of MEDICAL HERBS

On a quest to preserve medical herbs, Department of Commerce under the initiative of Prof. M.B Sasidharan exhibited common medicinal herbs at the Al-Ameen fest on 8-12-2015. The exhibition was part of a mission to identify and preserve hundreds of medicinal plants in the state.

There was a time when inhabitants relied completely on nature for their needs. Nature still provide us with everything essential but man has forgotten and neglected it seeking a substitute. The coming generation must be aware of such things and preserve this knowledge for the future.

Apart from this, it also helps the people in the Ulladan community to make a decent living as this is the only form of livelihood for them. The only thing the Ulladan tribe had was the forest surrounding them and this forced them to depend on nature and generate whatever was necessary from nature. Their knowledge was passed on to generations orally and practically. In this modern era, the members of the Ulladan tribe are those with great knowledge about the available medicinal herbs who provide the herbs and plants required for the ayurvedic treatments.

Ammini, an Ulladan tribal woman, who can identify 4000 types of medicinal plants and herbs was invited to the exhibition. She explained the medicinal value of herbs to the students. Palakayila, Gnapathy naranga, Chaturamulla, Thrithaali, Manjakoduveli, Keeyamellis all having a host of medicinal properties are some of the herbs that were exhibited.

PENSION SCHEME FOR THREE FAMILIES :

Our society and country has blessed us with an identity and sense of belongingness. It is our prime duty to pay back to the society whenever possible. 'Life Long Pension Scheme' exemplifies this ideal. A teacher must be a role model for the students. This practice initiated by the teachers has the goal of creating awareness among our students on moral values and social commitment. The Institution aims at inculcating a feeling of 'Give and share' relationship among student community.

Al-Ameen College, Edathala is located in a rural area which is socially and economically backward. The socio economic status of people living in this area was seen to be below average. Hence, the teaching staff of the Institution put forward the idea of implementing a system of monetary aid to those members of the society who sorely needed it. To ensure that this aid would not peter out, it was decided at the beginning to make it a 'lifelong pension' where the beneficiary could be assured of receiving it until his or her last breath. The aid of the Edathala Panchayath authorities were sought to identify the beneficiaries and the 'Life Long Pension Scheme' came into practice.

Staff Association collects the requisite contribution every month from each willing member. At present the selected needy receive Rs. 1000 per month.

AL-AMEEN BLOOMS WITH THEIR FARM

The Staff and students of Al-Ameen College, Edathala took organic farming to heart when they launched an organic drive along with the Krishi Bhavan, Edathala on 16-03-2016. Spinach, the seasonal crop of the time was mainly planted in a plot that faced the main college building. The seedlings that sprouted up fast were nurtured by the volunteers of the Nature Club which spearheaded the cultivation. Students willingly watered the seedlings and were gratified by their growth into bushy, healthy plants bearing the characteristic reddish glow of a well formed spinach plant. Prof M. B. Sasidharan , an organic farming enthusiast, took the lead in initiating the staff and students into organic fertilizers and pesticides. The reaping of the crop was held on 16-03-2016 along with the Agricultural Officer and other Krishi Bhavan representatives. The final motivation for organic farming came when the crop was taken home, cooked and eaten. The sublime taste of this spinach reflected the words of Alice Waters, chef, author, and owner of Chez Panisse. "Let things taste the way they are."

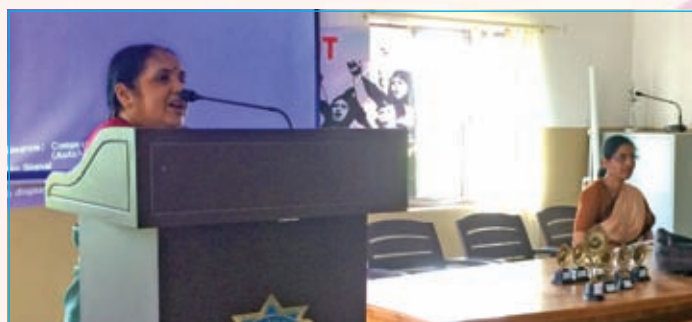
FLASH MOB:

On 28th September 2015, Department of Management organized industrial visit to Kitex Limited and Anna Aluminum at Kizhakkambalam.



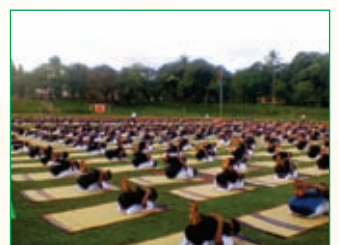
HOLISTIC YOGA THERAPY

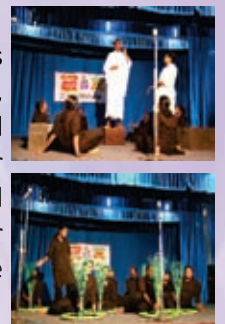


COUNSELOR

New Initiatives in Higher Education, Directorate of Collegiate Education, Government of Kerala

ASAP

Government of Kerala has initiated an ambitious programme, the Additional Skill Acquisition Programme (ASAP) with the objective of tackling the issue of growing unemployment in the state. The programme aims at equipping selected school/college students with skills in Communication, IT and selected areas of industry and service sectors. At Level 1, ASAP imparts 300 hours of skill training to selected first year students (30 per batch, maximum 2 batches in an institution). Of this, 180 hours is a foundation module comprising of Communication Skills and IT skills and the remaining 120 hours is the module related to the skill sector chosen by the student. ASAP has been launched in the college during 2014-15. The Classes under ASAP are engaged by Skill Development Executives.



SCHOLAR SUPPORT PROGRAMME

The Scholar Support Programme (SSP) is part of the 'New Initiatives in Higher Education' of the Department of Higher Education, Govt. of Kerala. This programme aims at overcoming the academic weakness of students who belong to the bottom of the merit hierarchy at the time of admissions. This compensatory programme aims at imparting additional support to students in areas where they are curricularly weak.

In our college, the SSP programme started in the academic year 2013-14 and still continuing. Under the given directions, as per direction a maximum of six subjects can be treated as difficult at the college level and a maximum of 50 students can be beneficiaries. One of the subjects selected is English for which 10 students were selected. The other subjects were selected as per the needs of the students and eight students were identified for each of these remaining 5 subjects. As per instructions, each student could be considered for only one subject other than English and the marks in the qualifying examination were to be used as the criterion for selection of students,

namely the lowest percentage of marks in the qualifying examination. As per provision, 20 sessions (10 in the first semester and 10 in the second semester), each of one hour duration has been imparted for each subject identified as difficult. The selected students shall get support for the entire period of the programme.

WALK WITH A SCHOLAR PROGRAMME

Walk With a Scholar (WWS) scheme is part of the New Initiatives in Higher Education, Directorate of Collegiate Education, Government of Kerala. This aims at providing specialized mentoring programmes for under graduate students in Arts, Science and Commerce with the intention of shaping their future career. The scheme introduces the idea of mentoring and builds on the concept of mentor as a 'Guide' and 'Friend'.

This scheme aims at giving necessary orientation to needy students, giving them proper guidance, motivation and mental support to identify appropriate areas of higher

study and to prepare them for employment. The students will be enabled to develop their skills, improve performance, manage their own learning, think about career options and become the person they want to be. For the purpose of mentoring, two categories of mentors are identified: 'Internal Mentors' and External Mentors'.

Internal Mentoring

There are a total of 10 internal mentors for the WWS Programme, all teachers from our own institution. They act as guides to mentor and support the scholars as well as in building their career.

External mentoring :

External Mentors are reputed persons outside the College who can strongly influence students and help them evolve into the person they want to be. External sessions organized in the academic year 2014-15 include:

- ★ Talk on Improving communicative skills and public speaking : The resource person of the session was Mr. Shibu Damodar of JCI (Junior Chamber International)
- ★ Talk on Self-awareness and Analysis : The resource person of the session was Mr. Nibu John (Junior Chamber International certified trainer)
- ★ Talk on leadership and Time Management (Mr. Harish Kumar of JCI (certified International Trainers certified trainer)

ADDITIONAL COURSES OFFERED FOR ACADEMIC FLEXIBILITY AND COMPETITIVE EXAMINATIONS

The following courses are offered in 2015-16 academic year for better academic flexibility.

✦ Add On Course

Two Add-On courses have been started with the support of the UGC in the academic year 2013 with the support of UGC. This scheme strives to link education with market-oriented skills that have utility for job, self employment and empowerment of the students. At the end of three years, the students will be equipped with an Add-On degree certificate along with a conventional degree in Science/Arts/Commerce. The Institution offers the courses 'Holistic Yoga Therapy' and 'Office Management with Tally'. There are 30 seats in each course.

✦ ISOLE training

Set in motion in the year 1998, ISOLE was the brain child of stalwarts like Dr. K. Jayakumar, IAS (Vice Chancellor, Malayalam University), Mrs. Lida Jacob, IAS, Dr. Baby (Department of Psychology, University of Calicut) and

Mr. K. Basheer (Former Deputy Director of Education, Malappuram). The sole idea of ISOLE is the improvement of academic excellence by bringing in changes wherever required.
