Preamble

A Green Campus is a place where environmental friendly practices and education combine to promote sustainable and eco-friendly practices in the campus. These strategies need to be incorporated into the institutional planning and budgeting processes with the aim of developing a clean and green campus.

Green and Clean Campus Policy:

Objectives:

1. Promote the culture of clean and green campus
2. Create a litter free campus
3. Discourage the use of plastic in campus
4. Minimize the use of printed material/notices and plastic pens
5. Encourage use of cloth or paper bags and paper pens and provide training to students to make them.
6. Use and sale of seed pens
7. Promote use of earthen pots
8. Switch from use and throw stationery items to reusable items
9. Promote the principle of Reduce, Reuse and Recycle.
10. Mandate segregation of waste at the source into biodegradable and non-biodegradable.
11. Convert waste into useful resources such as biogas, vermin compost etc.
12. Recycle e-waste and plastic waste.
13. Maintain the biodiversity of the campus through various thematic gardens.

Clean campus initiatives:

- Cleanliness awareness drives undertaken by various clubs and cells like NSS, NCC, and Nature club with the vision of Swachh Bharat Abhiyan.
- Encouraging students, teachers as well as non-teaching staff to participate in clean campus drives.

- Organising various competitions like poster making, essay writing, painting, poetry and other literary works to highlight importance of keeping environment and surroundings clean and safe.
- Arrange various expert talks, seminars, workshops etc to instil young minds with the importance of nature and environment protection and preservation.
- Conduct workshops and train last grade staff to maintain clean and safe campus
- Reduce, Reuse and Recycling of waste – waste management.
- Planting trees inside the campus in the name of retired staff and also promoting planting trees in the surroundings and outside campus.
- Free distribution of plant saplings to the public and students
- Conduct of Green audit periodically in the campus
