
Workshop on Paper Pen Making

LED tube assembling workshop

(21st November 2019)

During the energy audit, it was noticed that the energy consumption in the college can be managed if we adopt some new energy policies. With this idea, Physics Department came forward with two new initiatives. The first one was to initiate awareness programmes and energy conservation activities through a flagship programme named 'ENLIT AL AMEEN'.

Towards the aim of replacing old bulbs and tubes with LED devices, an incubation unit named LED HUB was started. As a first step, training was given to students in assembling LED tubes and bulbs. Some selected students were trained to

assemble the devices on a programme conducted on November 21, 2019 and they will be utilized for assembling the entire devices needed to replace the old tubes in the campus. With the support from college management, the raw materials were purchased. But due to the unexpected pandemic situation and the subsequent lock down, we were not able to complete the project in the expected period.

ENLIT AL AMEEN

(5th & 6th November 2020)

A light emitting diode (LED) is a device which converts electrical energy in to light. It is the newest and most exciting technological advancement in the lighting industry, which appeared relatively recently and gained popularity in our market because of its advantages – high-quality illumination, long life, reduced power consumption.

Post the energy audit of our campus, we realized the scope of replacing all the traditional light sources to LEDs and thereby conserving electricity. Thus, the Department of Physics started a program 'Enlit Al-Ameen' to replace all the light sources with LED bulbs and tube lights and thereby transforming Al-Ameen to a hundred percent energy efficient campus in the coming years. Last year we purchased the items for assembling, but due to the unexpected pandemic situation we were not able to assemble the same. Department of Physics in association with

Energy Management Cell of Al Ameen College conducted two-day workshop on “Enlit Al Ameen with Eco-friendly and Energy-efficient light” on 5th and 6th November 2020 in the physics lab. Aim of the programme was to upgrade the Al Ameen College as an eco-friendly and energy efficient campus. The trained students of the physics department assembled the tubes. We were able to produce 45 LED tubes and our Vice Principal Prof. Indu G switched on the tubes on November 5, 2020.


ETHICS AND VALUE EDUCATION CLUB


Report – Future Audio – Workshop by Albin Andrew

Mr. Albin took over the session by introducing his current work profile and demonstrated various projects which he is currently working on. He explained to the students, the role of Artificial Intelligence in audio recording. Various examples and websites that uses AI were introduced to the students. Albin also showed demo of various audio technology that are currently developed in labs, but not available as an end-customer product yet. 
Nuts and bolts of Capital market



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REPORT ON MUSHROOM CULTIVATION

DEPARTMENT OF BIOTECHNOLOGY

Mushrooms have been valued throughout the world for their medicinal value and as a food for thousands of years. They are a rich source of nutrition with less fat and they also consist predominantly of unsaturated fatty acids such as linoleic acid. Hence mushroom is considered as the perfect food for maintaining a healthy heart and cardiovascular system.

Mushroom cultivation has become a very lucrative pursuit in recent years, with more and more people turning to it and striking gold. In addition to that, understanding its remunerative potential, the centre and state agricultural departments have also been vociferously endorsing mushroom farming.

The Department of Biotechnology, Al-Ameen College, Edathala started mushroom cultivation during the academic year 2019-20. Prior to that the department also started a certificate course on mushroom production technology with an objective to induce self directed and experiential learning among students. The guidelines for mushroom production was provided by Mr. Sreekumar, Veggie White Mushrooms, Perumbavoor. Veggie White also provided a one day workshop on mushroom cultivation. 75 students participated in the workshop.

Later the department decided to start mushroom production. Ms. Sanooja MS was the Team Leader for the mission. Oyster mushrooms with high nutritional quality were cultivated in the department unit. Initially 25 beds were maintained and harvested. Mushrooms were made available to different departments and to the college employees in a packet of 100 gm and 250 gm with fixed rates.



SAP Students Workshop

Department of BCom CA organised an E- Workshop on SAP [System Applications and Products in Data Processing] for the students on 6th March, 2021. Mr. Sajad M A of Vintage Info solutions, Aluva was the key speaker.

The workshop was aimed at imparting basic knowledge of SAP, an enterprise application software suite that can be used to manage SAP Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP). SAP helps organizations to integrate different business units and partners. It has four modules- Financial, HR, Logistical and Cross Applications. Mr.

Sajad explained that comprehensive training in SAP would help students to get global recognition, additional packages and promotions in career. He concluded that, in the challenging job market adding extra professional skills is very important and hence SAP course is an excellent step towards a secure future.




Report – Sound in Film – Workshop by Arun Rama Varma





She concluded the session by reminding everyone about the importance of timely reporting of sexual, domestic or public abuse against women to the concerned authorities since time plays a significant role in proving that, most of these cases are to be reported without delay or shyness.

The topic of discussion for the fourth and the concluding day of the webinar series was about 'Gender based Violence & Women rights. The resource person for the program was Ms. Deepa M.S, Women Protection Officer, Ernakulam. The chief guest clearly explained about the various acts and laws that can be availed for violence against women. Violence against women and girls comes in different forms including domestic violence, sexual assault and harassment, early and forced marriage, sex trafficking, etc. She pointed out that it is one of the most widespread violations of human rights and has long-term devastating effects on the lives of women, their communities and the society.

The four day webinar series finished on a high note with participants discussing the various aspects mentioned throughout this string program. It was a highly informative session as well as of at most importance. The participants provided positive feedbacks

since they received an information filled campaign about gender equality and sexual abuse against women.




WEBINAR REPORT - MANAGING BUSINESS THROUGH THE TIMES OF CRISIS.
