
### 1. Workshop on Problem Solving, Ideation and Pitching





Institution Innovation Council in association with IEDC has organized a workshop on Problem solving, Ideation and Pitching for the IIC student members on 3 November 2022 in the board



2. Field Visit on Problem Identification




### 7. Certificate Course in Soft Skill and Professional Enhancement

## 8. <u>Hands on Training Workshop on Mushroom Production</u> <u>Technology</u>





Mushrooms represent microbial technology that recycles agriculture residues into food and manure. Mushrooms provide several important nutrients that are needed by the body. Mushroom cultivation can help reduce vulnerability to poverty and strengthens livelihoods through the generation of a fast yielding and nutritional source of food and a reliable source of income. The Department of Biotechnology in association with IEDC, IIC has organized training workshop on mushroom production technology on 15 December 2022. The coordinator of the program was Ms. Sanooja M S. The major objective of the programme was to provide guidelines for mushroom cultivation so that cultivation on extensive scale can help solve many problems of global importance such as protein shortage, resource recovery and reuse as part of environmental management. The training was offered to all students of the college. Mr. A Sreekumar, Director of Veggie White Mushrooms was the master of the session . The syllabus of the programme includes; types of mushrooms, edible mushrooms, economic value of mushrooms etc. He dealt with the normal cultivation as well as the tissue culture practices of mushroom cultivation. Students were provided with a hands-on training on mushroom bed preparation, spawning and maintenance of mushroom. The programme was a grant success and come up with the most favourable response.
