## CONSOLIDATED REPORT 2022-2023

The EEEEC program for the year 2022-23 commenced on 12<sup>th</sup> September 2023 with Shamna S and Hasna V A as instructors. The classes were arranged for the first year students of various departments. Intense training in English language and communication skills were given. Classes were included as part of regular time table and the students were given rigorous training in group discussion, interview skills and personality development. Formal and informal speaking sessions enabled the students to understand the nuances of communication. The classes were organized in an activity oriented method which helped the students to improve their skills with expert insights in communication, leadership and to expand their knowledge. At the end of the year a detailed interview session was carried out in each class and an oral test on communication skills was also conducted.

In connection with the English Efficiency Enhancement Course a one day seminar named "The Sur-Plus Insights" was conducted on 14th November, 2022 in the seminar hall. The programme was organised in association with English Plus Language Academy, Calicut. A total of 100 students participated in the programme. The students actively participated in each task and displayed greater enthusiasm as a team. The programme succeeded in inculcating a team spirit and providing a different experience of language learning.

A three-day Workshop on effective communication were also organised for the teachers from various schools under Al Ameen Trust. The program was organized as a one-day workshop for each school. A total of 198 teachers from five different schools participated in the program held at Al Ameen College and Al Ameen school, Edappally on 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, and 16<sup>th</sup> of May 2023. The workshop introduced various language learning techniques through activity-oriented sessions.

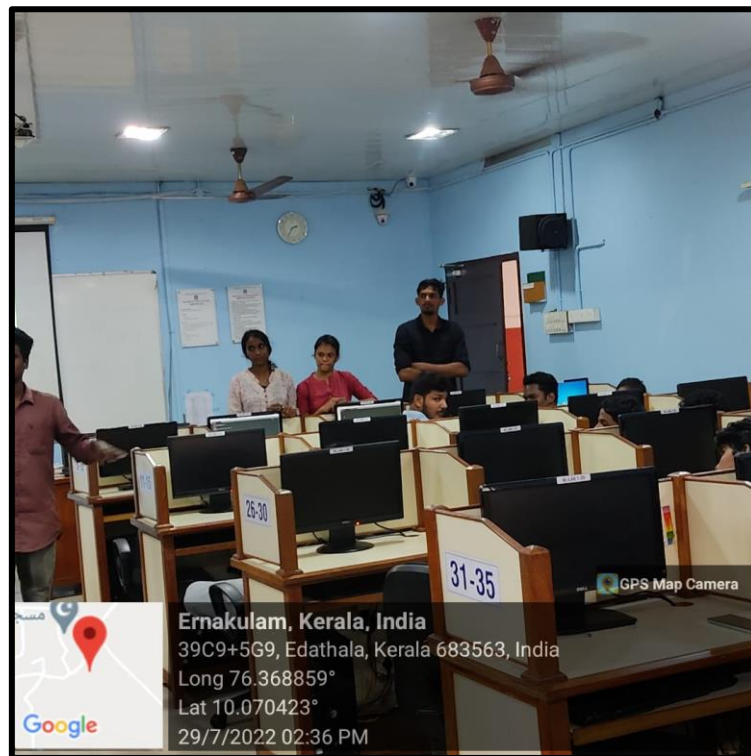
## 1. Workshop On Ethical Hacking

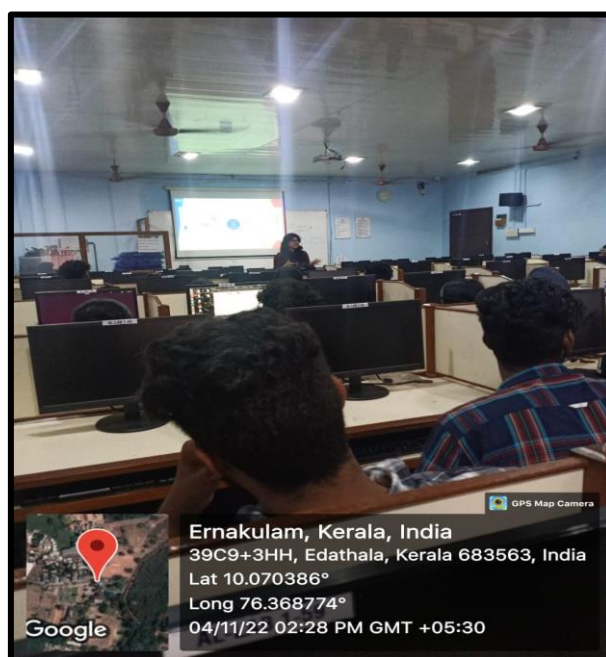


## 2. Skill Development Class : Data Mining

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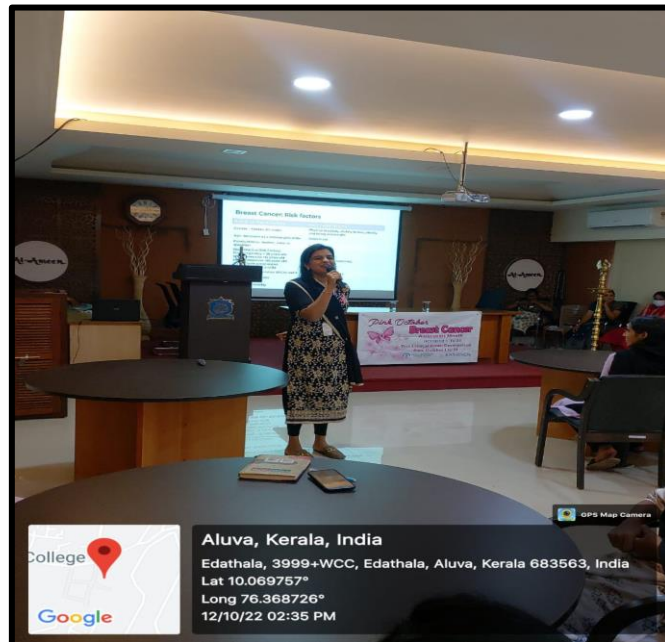
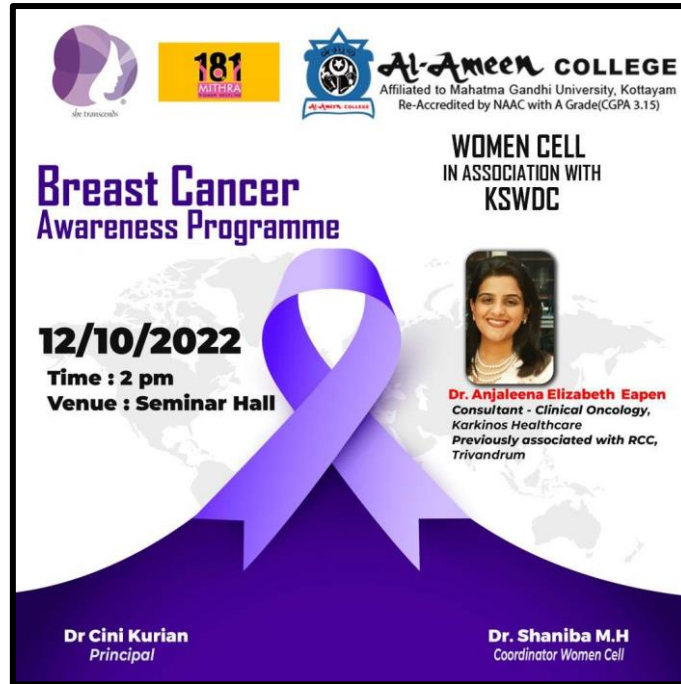

### 3. International Yoga Day Celebration



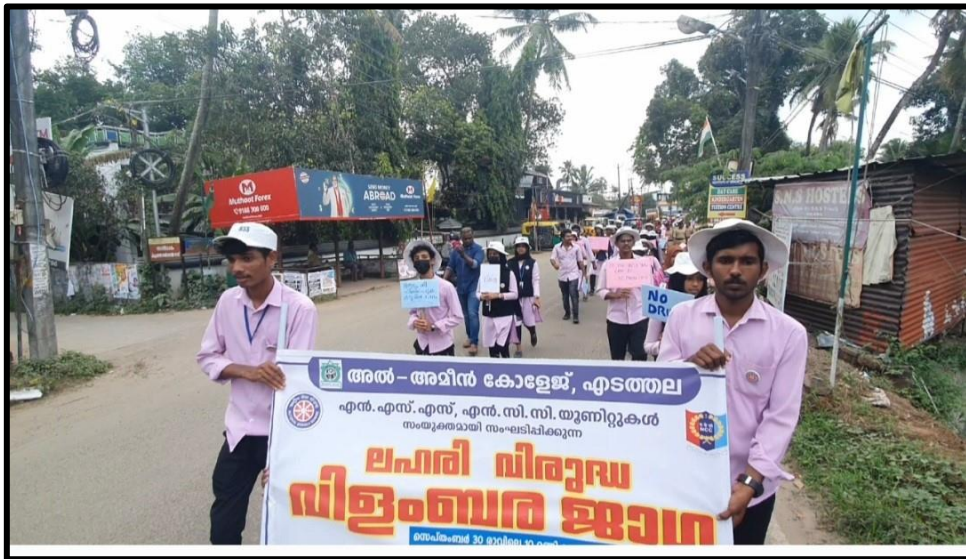

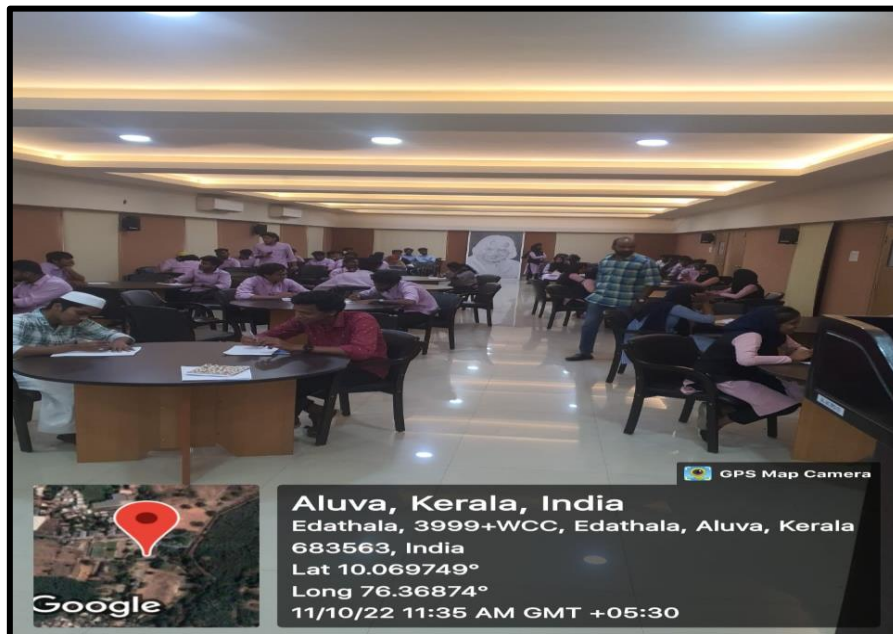
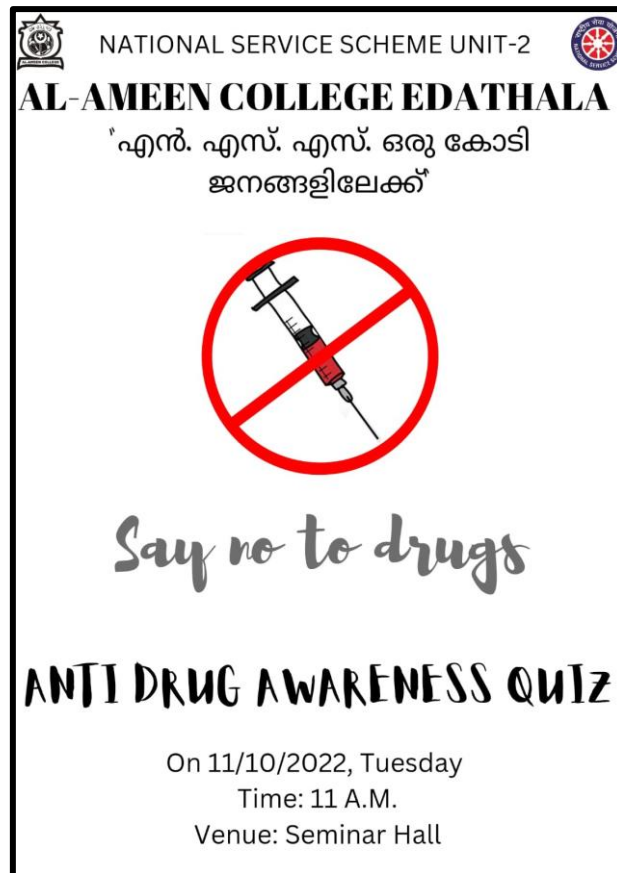


## 6. Anti-Drug Awareness Campaign- Chief Minister Inauguration

## 9. Anti-Drug Awareness Campaign- Human Chain



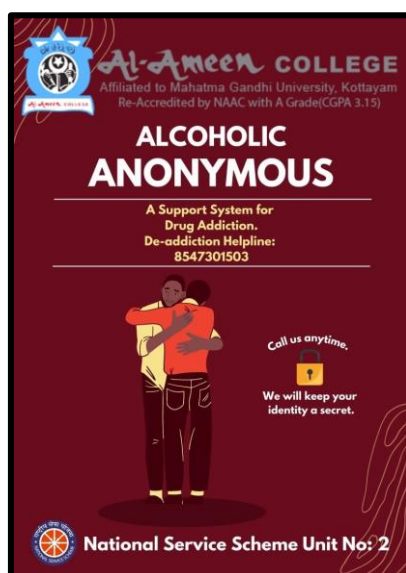
