INTRODUCTION

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Al Ameen College, Edathala has been the guiding light of the college activities since its inception in 2012. The core team members of IQAC who played a vital role in ensuring academic excellence and quality in all operations is lead by Dr. Cini Kurian, Principal of the College as the IQAC Chairperson and Dr. Leena Varghese, Assistant Professor as the Coordinator. The academic year 2020-21 was a milestone year in the history of Al Ameen College, as we completed the arduous journey of NAAC Reaccreditation Process with awarding of A grade with a CGPA of 3.15. The college participated in the 3rd cycle of NIRF ranking system and was also part of Atal Ranking of Institutions on Innovation Achievements (ARIIA) for the first time.

This report is a reflection of the college's performance in the academic year and renewal of the vision-mission statement of the college and the challenges faced due to the pandemic. The first wave of the pandemic hit India in March 2019 that led to a nationwide lockdown and changed the majority of the academic activities online as per the directions of Mahatma Gandhi University. Anticipating the same, the IQAC of the college aimed for digital equality within and without the campus by providing 'tabs' as an online learning tool for students who are struggling with technology in limited circumstances. Moreover, the IQAC organized a training programme on Moodle software for the newly appointed teachers for a more effective and accessible way to share materials, assignments, other resources. Introduction of VPL, an activity module for Moodle was another initiative of IQAC as a feasible solution for providing hands on sessions for programming subjects. These kinds of preparations really improved the quality of curriculum delivery and helped in the smooth transition to online mode of education.
