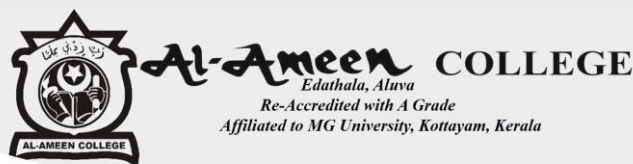
ONE DAY INDUSTRIAL VISIT

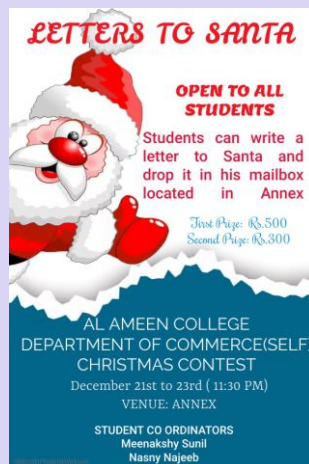
CHOCOLATE FACTORY VISIT

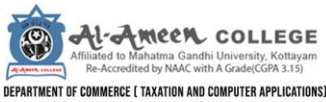
CHRISTMAS PROGRAMME - WRITE A LETTER TO SANTA


MERIT DAY- "WINGS OF EXCELLENCE"

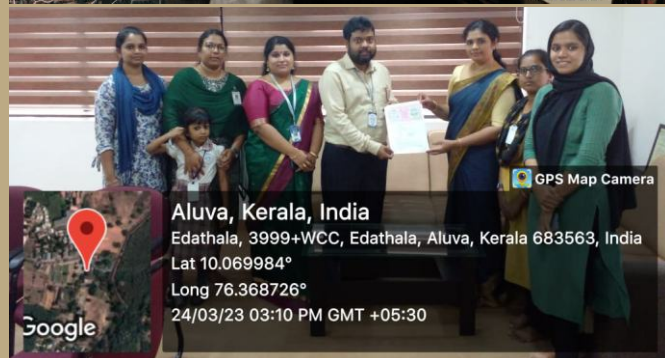

WATER QUALITY ANALYSIS LABORATORY INAUGURATION

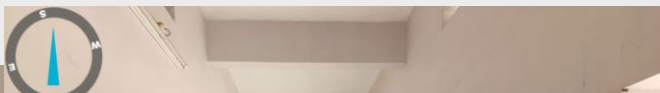

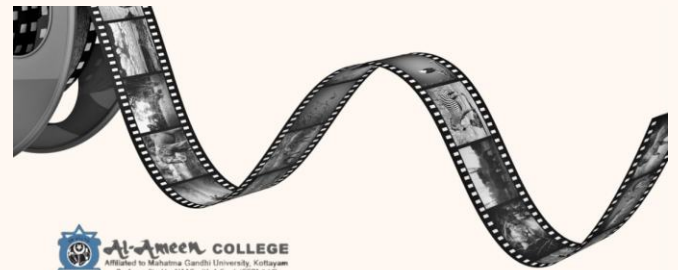

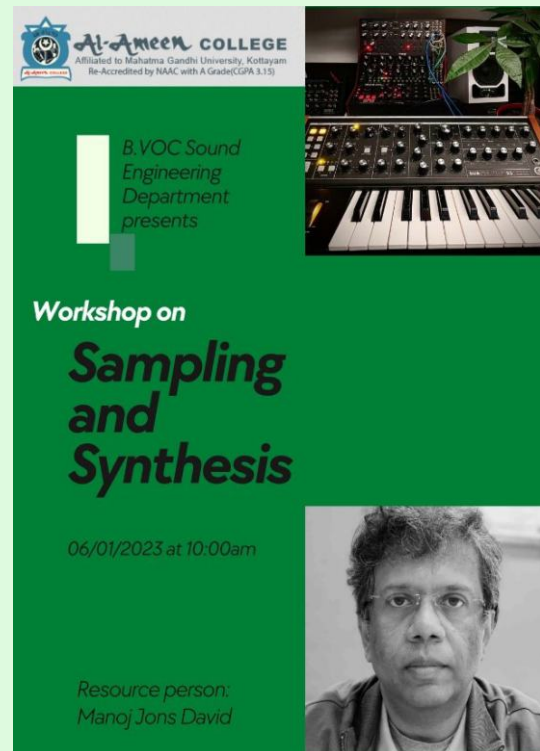

The event concluded at 5 pm with a vote of thanks by Adhil Locson, thanking the college authorities and teachers for making this event a great success.

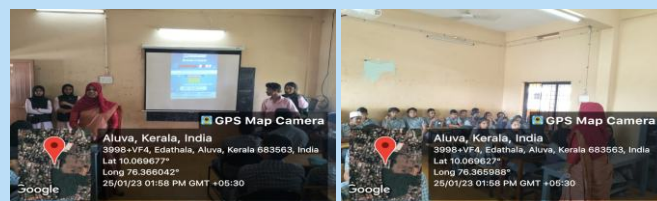


CHEMISTRY

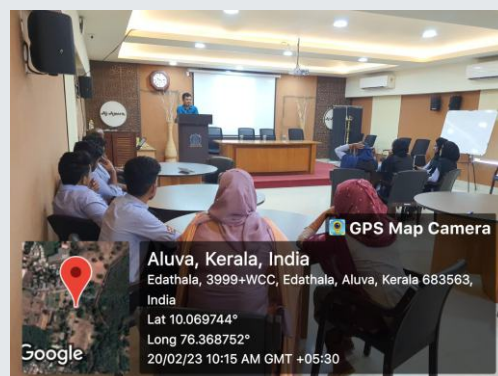

WONDERS OF CHEMISTRY ALCKEMY 2K23

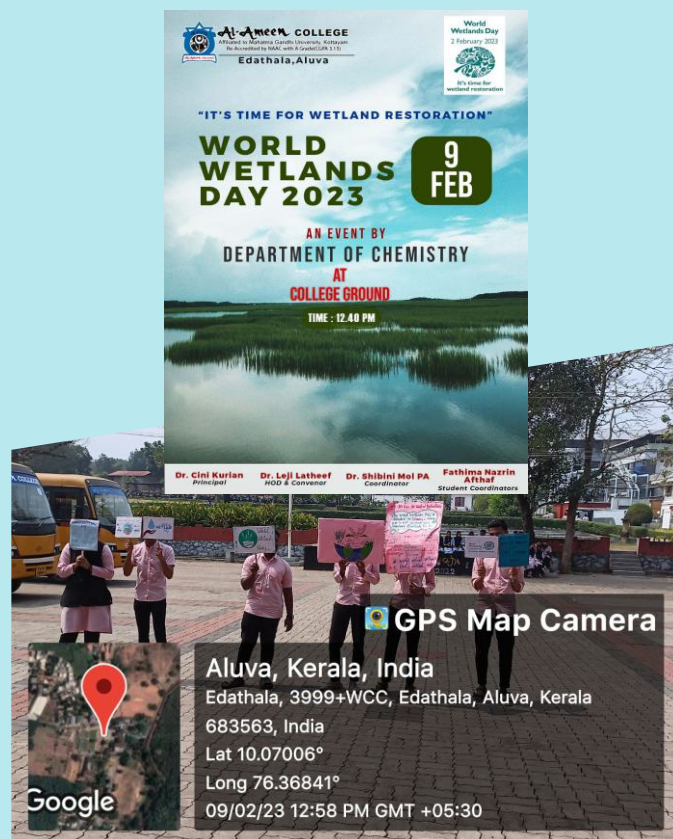

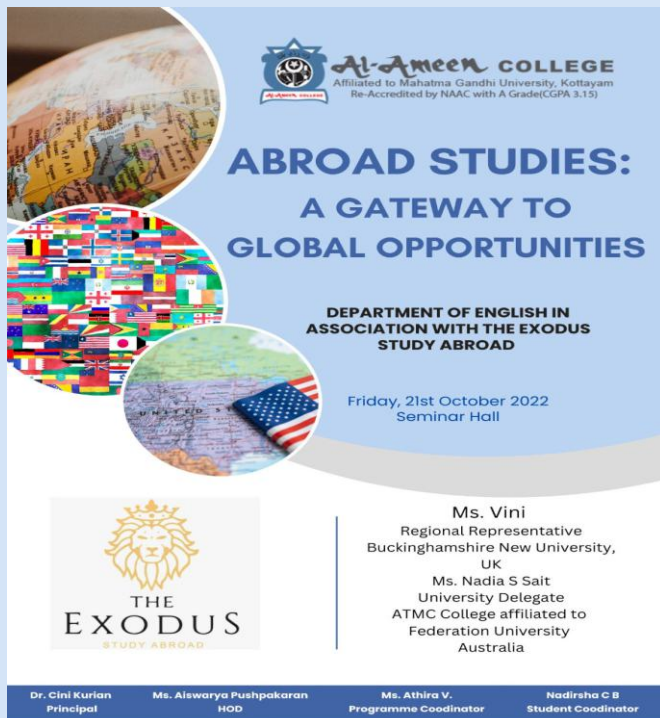

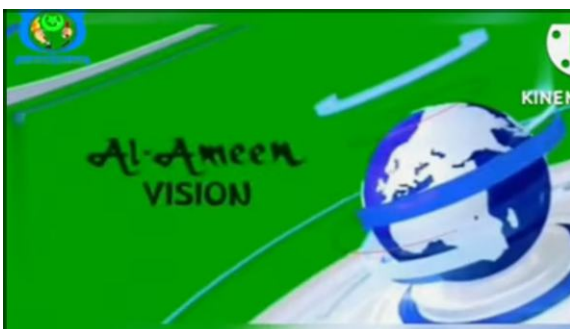
ACHIEVEMENTS OF 22-23

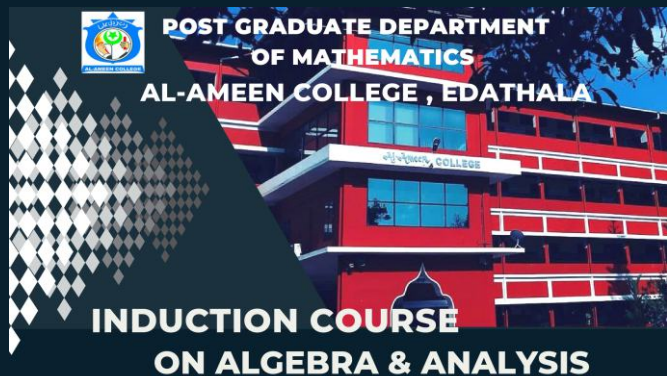
INDUCTION COURSE ON ALGEBRA & ANALYSIS

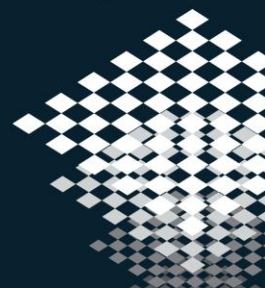




DEPARTMENT OF PHYSICS

WAVELET REGULARISATION IN QUANTUM FIELD THEORY

The Department of Physics, Al-Ameen College, Edathala, organised a seminar on the topic "Wavelet Regularisation in Quantum Field Theory" on August 16, 2022. The seminar started at 11:00 a.m. in the Seminar Hall. Head of the Department of Physics, Mrs. Hiba Rahman, welcomed the eminent resource person, Dr. M. Altaisky, and the gathered students and faculty. Dr. MIKHAIL Mikhail Altassky is a leading scientist at the Space Research Institute RAS, Profsoyuznaya, Moscow, Russia. The Speaker elaborated on how, in Quantum Field Theory(QFT), the amplitude computed from the Feynman diagrams is divergent. People usually use regularisation and renormalization tricks to resolve this divergence. Prof. M.V. Altaisky discussed how to resolve the divergence using wavelet transform methods. His team's findings demonstrated that no physical quantity can be measured sharp at a point but can be measured in a region. In the talk, he presented the results of the Euclidean wavelet QED model and QCD. After the talk students could exchange their perspectives on theoretical research in the context of international scenario. The seminar concluded around 12.30 p.m. Ms Sumayya, from MSc. Physics proposed the vote of thanks on the occasion.

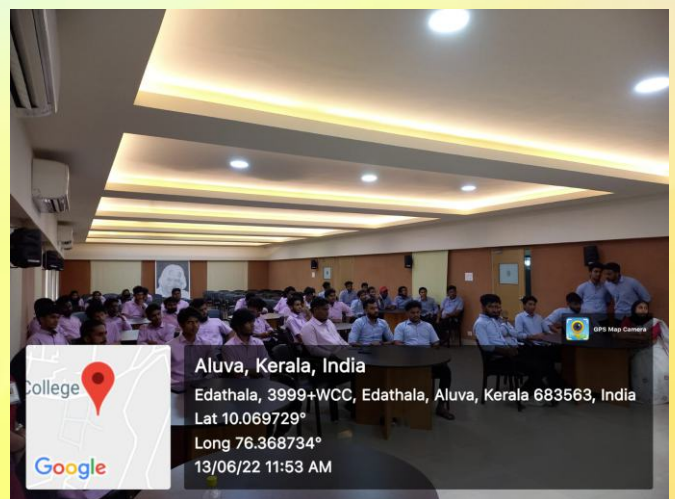


DEPARTMENT OF TOURISM

FIELD VISIT TO FORT COCHIN

The Tourism Department of Al-Ameen College, Edathala, organized a field visit to Fort Cochin on 08th June 2022. The journey started from campus at 9.30 am and reached the destination at about 11 am. The city derives its name from the Malayalam word 'Kochazhi' meaning small lagoon. The field trip covered many areas in and around Fort Kochi. It was a wonderful experience to gain practical knowledge in theoretical class.



HERITAGE VISIT TO HILL PALACE, THIRIPUNITURA

The Department of Tourism, Al Ameen College decided to conduct a visit to the Hill Palace Museum at Thripunithura on 11th of November 2022. Hill Palace is the largest archeological museum in Kerala, located at Tripunithura, Kochi. It was the imperial administrative office and official residence of Cochin Maharaja. Built in 1865, the palace complex consists of 49 buildings in the traditional architectural style, spreading across 54 acres (220,000 m²). The complex has an archaeological museum, a heritage museum, a deer park, a pre-historic park and a children's park. The campus of the museum is home to several rare species of medicinal plants. Presently the palace has been converted into a museum by The Kerala State Archaeology Department and is open to public. The palace is about 10 kilometers (6.2 mi) from the city centre and is approachable by road and rail.

The Centre for Heritage Studies (CHS), an autonomous research and training institute set up by the Department of Cultural Affairs, Government of Kerala also functions at the site. CHS is designated as the 'Manuscript Conservation Centre' (MCC) and Manuscript Resource Centre (MRC) by the National Mission for Manuscripts.

The Department of Tourism's students visited the museum where they saw Maharajas' jewellery, art galleries, and mural paintings among other things. The team had lunch at 1 pm and reached college by 2.30.

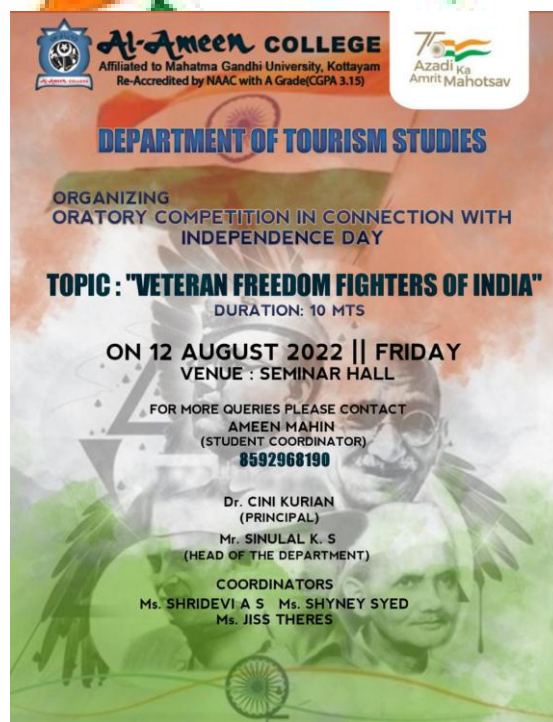

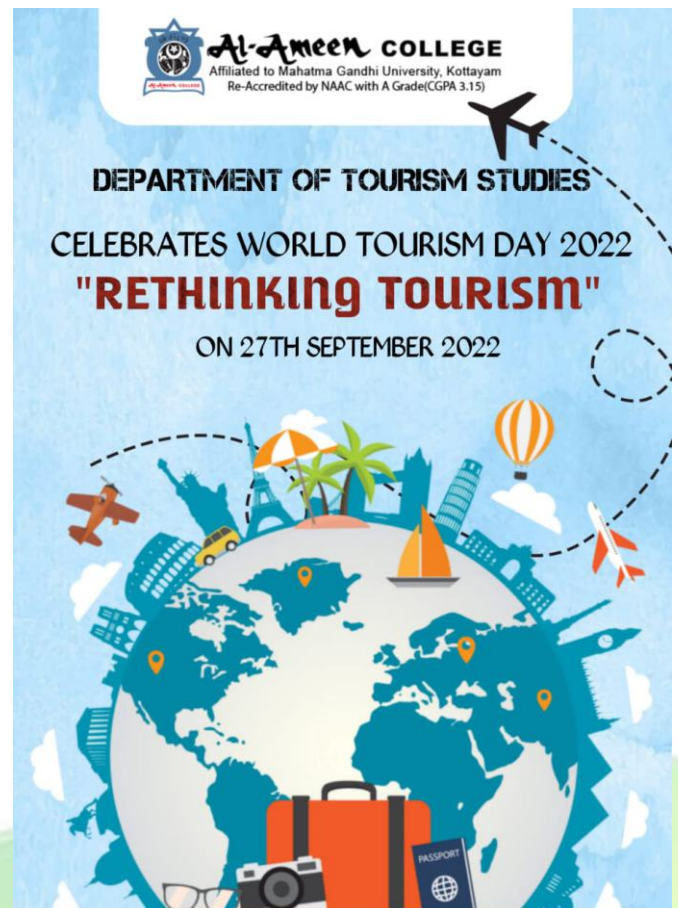

ECONOMIC SYSTEMS AND INDIAN ECONOMY: FUTURE PROSPECTUS OF ECONOMICS

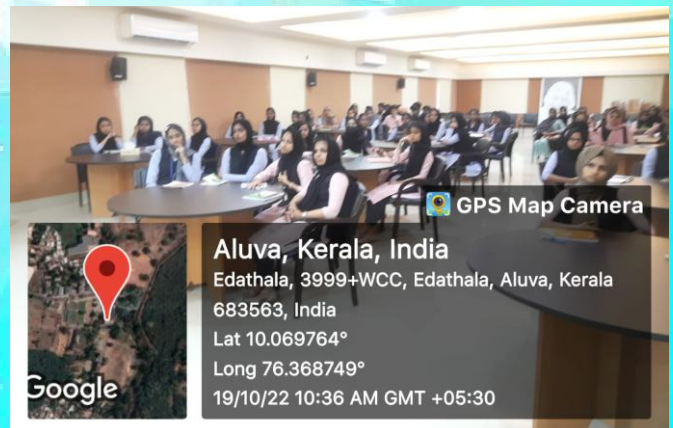
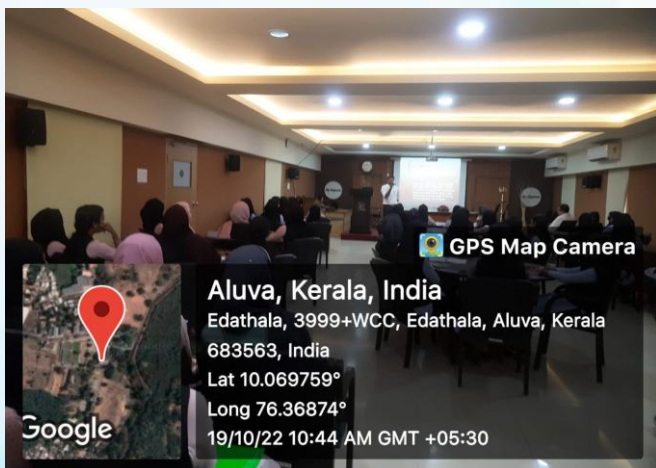

ONE STEP TOWARDS BETTER FUTURE

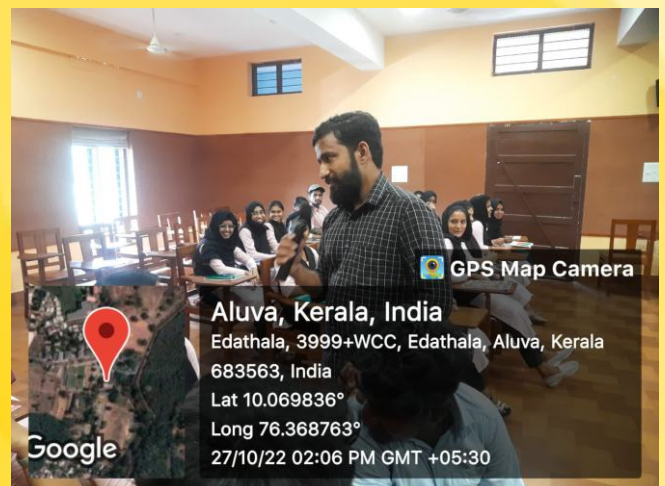
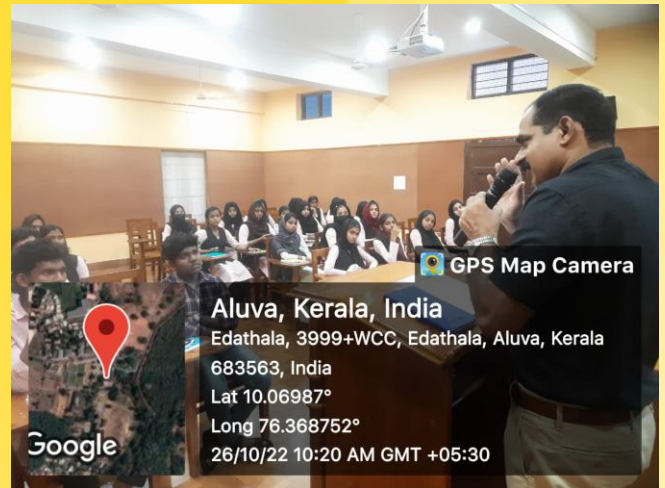

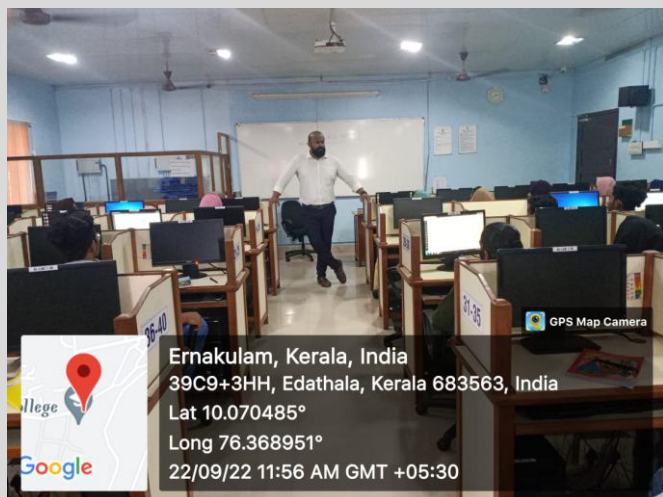
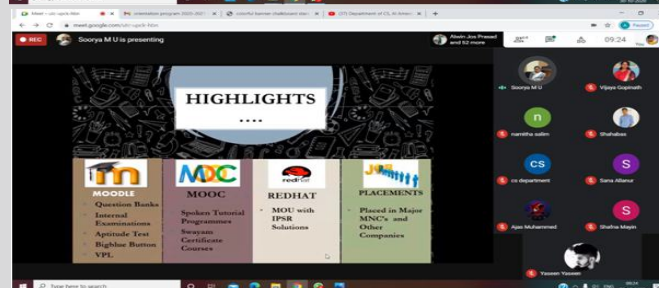
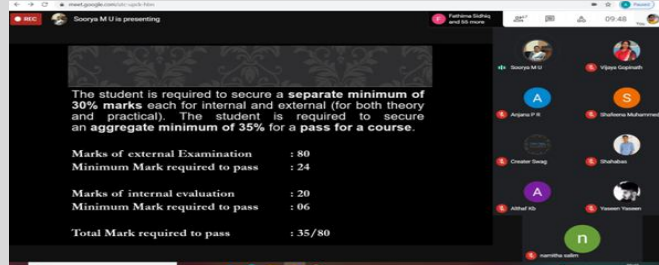
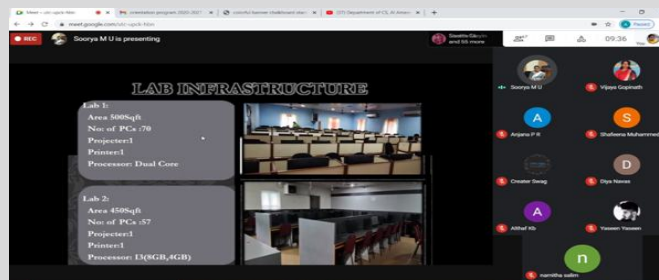


ORIENTATION PROGRAMME

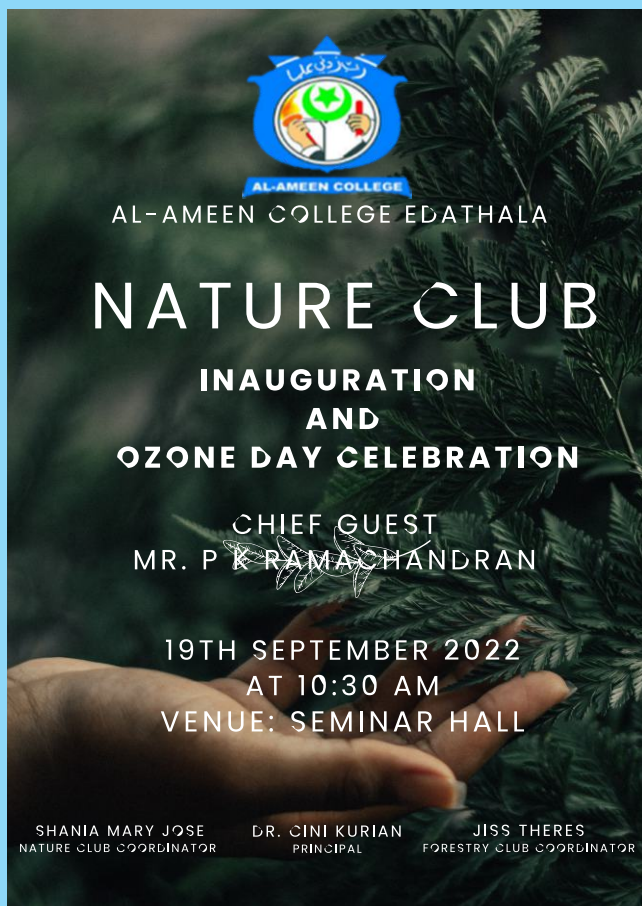
FOREST DEPARTMENT SURVEY

NATURE TOUR TO PONNAKUDAM KAVU

Ponnakudam Kavu, located roughly 4 km from the college, reveals its magic on about 4 acres of land, right in the middle of all the hustle and bustle. The 300-year-old Ponnakudam Kavu, managed by the Thevakkal Ponnakudam family is a home to hundreds of rare species of plants, trees, shrubs, insects, animals, and birds, many of which are under threat of extinction. The Nature Club took its student members to this wonderland of biodiversity. Mr P. K. Ramachandran, a member of the Ponnakudam family, explained how the concept of Kavu came into being. PARISTHITHIKAM -2022

BAMBOO FOREST AND PLAYGROUND AT KOYILERIMALA

Together with the Directorate of Environment and Climate Change at Edathala Al Ameen College, the college received the first payment for the Paristhithikam Project in August 2022. 

A GREEN APPROACH IN RESEARCH – IMPORTANCE OF BIOPOLYMERS FOR SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT

The Research Promotion Council, in association with the Department of Chemistry, conducted a seminar on the topic "A Green Approach in Research: Importance of Biopolymers for Sustainable Development." Dr. Sreekala MS, Associate Professor, School of Chemical Sciences, and Joint Director, International and Inter-University Centre for Nano Science and Nano Technology, IIUCNN, and School of Nano Science and Technology, Mahatma Gandhi University Kottayam, was the speaker. 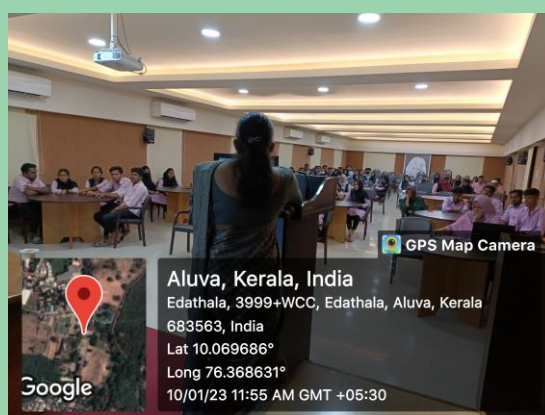

ACADEMIC WRITING AND RESEARCH PUBLICATIONS

The Research Promotion Council conducted a webinar on the topic "Academic Writing and Research Publications" by Dr. Siraj K.K; Assistant Professor Finance, Modern College of Business & Science, External Reviewer, OAAAQA, Sultanate of Oman, on March 9, 2023, in the seminar hall. The webinar was organized to encourage research among our P.G. students and faculty members who are currently pursuing PhDs. The focus area was the process of research and academic writing for research publications.

The speaker explained the eight steps in the process of research from identifying the research problem to writing the research report. He explained the methods to identify a research problem and the importance of reviewing the literature, which equips the researcher with enhanced knowledge to efficiently follow the research process. He described setting the research questions, choosing the research design and sampling design, data collection and analysis, and finally writing the research report. Everything was explained in detail in a very simple way.

Dr. Siraj clearly explained the academic writing techniques for journal publications. He discussed the importance of understanding the publishing process and the peer review process. The reasons for the rejection of research papers were explained. The session was a boon for young researchers to upgrade their work in a well-structured manner. The audience interacted well and their doubts were cleared. The session was fruitful and around 50 students attended.

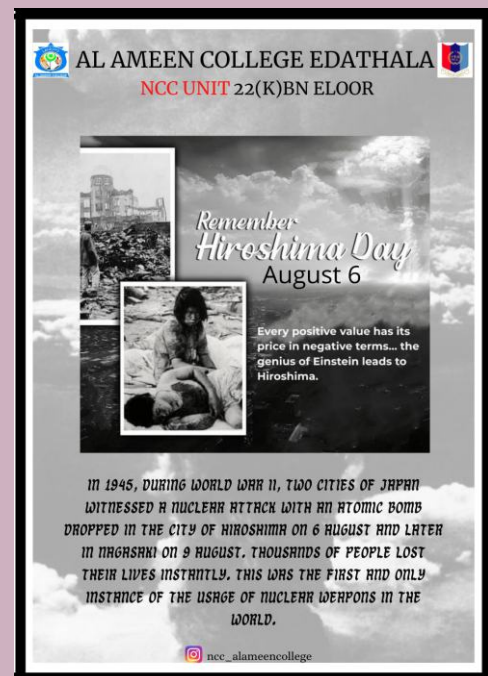


COMMUNITY EXTENSION PROGRAMME

AGRICULTURAL CENSUS



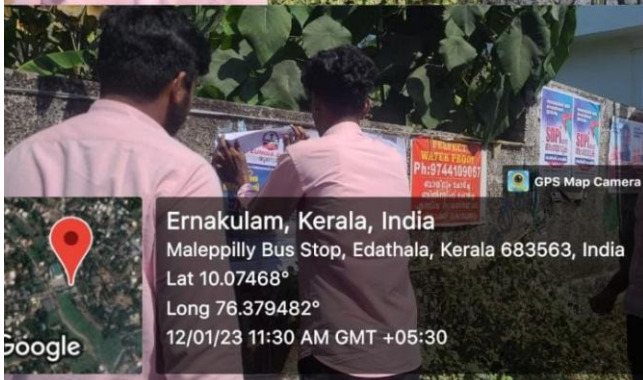
Essay Writing Competition

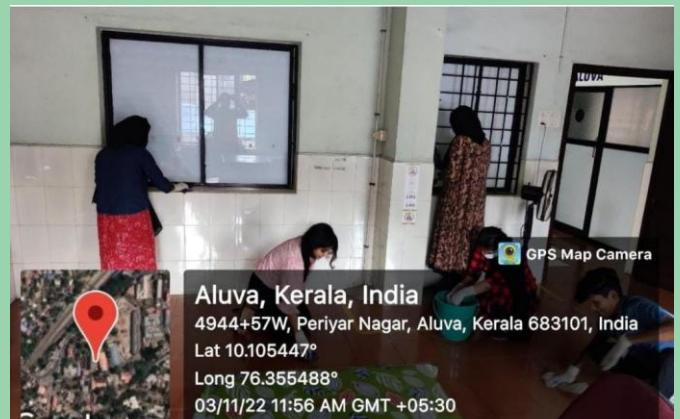
FREEDOM WALL

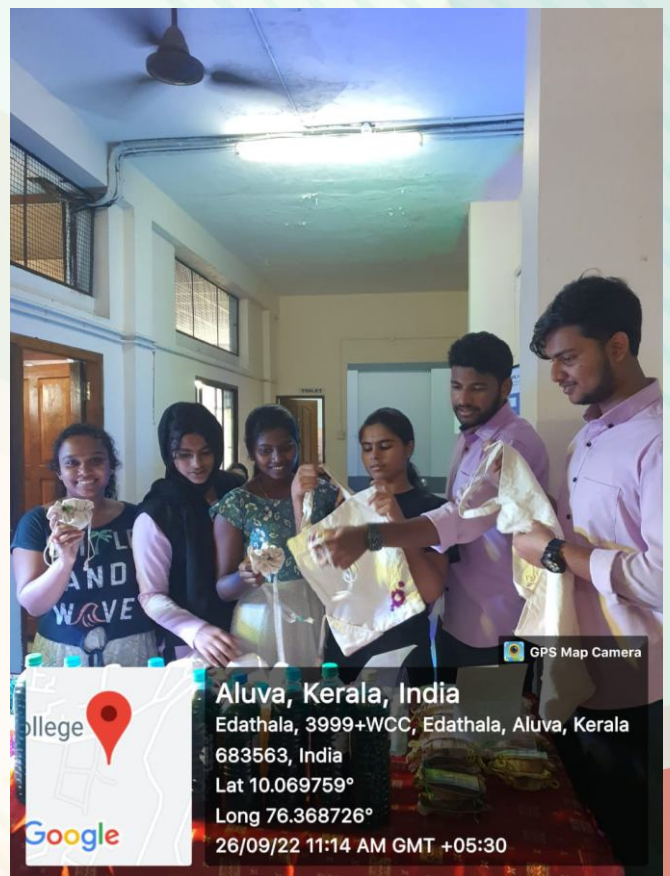
NATURE CAMP AT PAMPADUM SHOLA

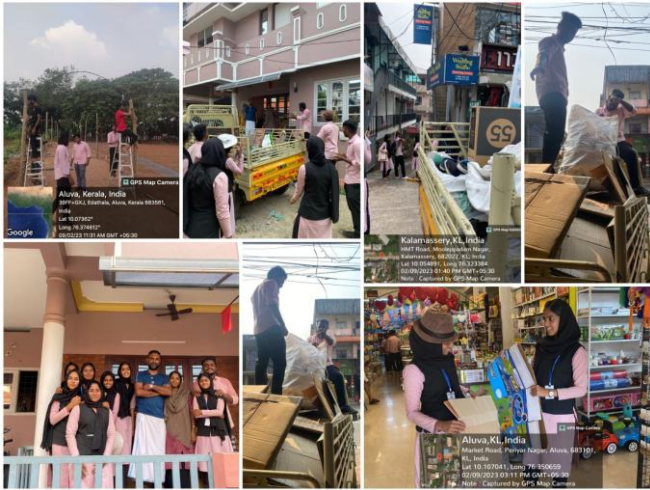
